

Materials List for Portrait Drawing Class

Please feel free to bring whatever drawing tools you would like for this class.

Some suggestions for things with which to experiment:

Graphite Pencils – a range from Hard to Soft (H=Hard, B=Soft – HB is the equivalent of a #2 Pencil)

Charcoal:

Vine Charcoal (soft & medium) thin (you can also get thick sticks if you want to experiment)

Charcoal Pencil in a range of softness from HB to 6B

Compressed Charcoal White

Newsprint Pad - No smaller than 9"x12"

Good Quality Paper Pad (for longer poses) – White or tinted paper is fine. No smaller than 9"x12"

Kneaded Eraser

Pink Pearl Eraser

Chamois

Tortillon/blending stumps

Sandpaper Pad for Sharpening

X-Acto Knife for sharpening pencils (you can also use a pencil sharpener if you prefer)

Ink Pens

Colored Pencils
